We are looking for enthusiastic drivers who enjoy being part of an experienced and supportive team. Our Driver volunteers are reliable and committed, helping to keep our busy service moving.

You will be friendly and welcoming, and keen to help our diverse service and its people. This is a time that can be particularly distressing for them, we aim to ease the process of adjusting to life in a new country through our support.

What you will be doing

- Drive a British Red Cross or your own vehicle to collect or distribute food or clothing
- Keep records of deliveries, collections and places visited
- Help with the movement and storage of stock

The skills you need

- Possess a Full Driving License that allows you to drive in the UK
- Strong communication skills and empathetic about the situation and needs of refugees, asylum seekers and vulnerable migrants
- Able to volunteer in a multicultural environment
- Good teamwork skills and a willingness to support where needed
- Speak English; knowledge of another language would be helpful (particularly one used in the current local refugee population)
- Able to lift, move and store stock safely
- Keep the people we support at the heart of what you do

- All training and induction for the role (there is no charge for training)
- Reasonable pre-agreed travel expenses for the role
